The Medical Mission provides dental care.

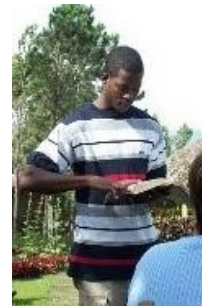

The Trip

- Annual 2 week trip during the month of June to the Santiago/Moca region of the DR.
- Volunteers choose a 1 week trip, or the full 2 week trip.

- Mission provides:
 - Clinical examinations
 - Prescriptions
 - Minor and major surgeries
 - Eye examinations and glasses
 - Dental exams
 - Oral surgeries
 - Health education
 - Breast Cancer Awareness
- Spiritual focus includes daily devotionals at camp, special worship services and outreach to the patients
- MMI team consists of 60 - 90 volunteers from around the country
- Minimum age is 16. (High School students require an accompanying adult representative)
- In previous trips, the IOF medical team treated over 1200 patients, and receives several professions of faith.
- Medical professionals and general helpers are needed. (Medical background not required for general helpers)
- Fellowship with other missionaries at game/sharing nights.
- Group Beach Day included.

Cost: One week = \$1295.00 + airfare
Cost: Two week = \$1550.00 + airfare
Fundraisers offset these costs
